- 1** There are no special tests for people with disabilities to register to vote in Nebraska.
- 2** You have the right to vote by mail or in person. It's your choice.
- 3** You have the right to vote even if you live in a group home or facility.
- 4** You can vote by yourself, or with help from a friend, family member, or even one of the people working at the place where you go to vote.
- 5** Even if you have a Guardian, Payee, or Conservator, you have the right to vote unless a judge has specifically taken that right away.
- 6** Registering to vote and voting are both free to everybody.
- 7** You have the right to vote however you want. This means that nobody is allowed to tell you who or what to vote for or against. It's your choice.
